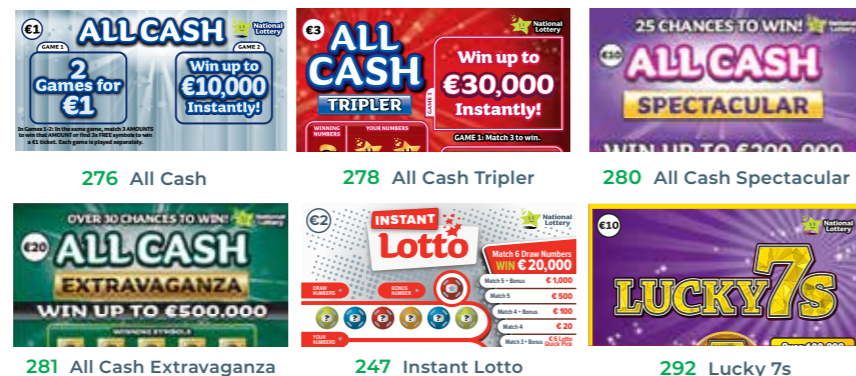
New End Activation/Remove From Sale Process

In order to improve and simplify the game end process for Retailers and to allow for the orderly removal of a game from sale once game end is announced we have extended the End Activation date to align with the Remove from Sale date. When PLI cease distributing a game to allow for its successor to be introduced to market there will be a full 12 weeks sell through period before the instruction to remove the game from sale is issued. During this time activations both manual and auto will be allowable. *This will not apply to 'hard stop' or 'seasonal' games which must be withdrawn immediately after the designated sales period ends.*

This will ensure Retailers have adequate time to sell through stock and/or return stock through their local Sales Representative. The National Lottery's Retail Support team will communicate the Remove from Sale dates in advance through the Portal and Terminal messaging.

Games Due to End this Quarter

The following games must be removed from sale before **30th September 2023**. Please see table for successor game information. Remember the activation window will remain open until the remove from sale date. The National Lottery Retail Support team will issue a series of communications advising retailers of these dates closer to the time via email & terminal messaging.



Note: the last date for returning Games 227/248/249/263/264 & 277 is 14th August 2023. If by chance you have any stock of these games on hand, please contact your local Sales Representative to arrange collection.

Draw Game Promotions

Ireland Only Raffle - 2 Millionaires Guaranteed in Ireland

We are planning an IRELAND ONLY RAFFLE in July and August where 2 lucky players will win a Guaranteed €1 Million. The promotion will take place over two EuroMillions Draws, Friday 28th July and Friday 11th August 2023. As with normal draw procedures, 10 raffle codes will be generated for both draws with each winning €5,000. One of the ten winners in each draw will win an additional €1 Million added to their prize.



€1 Million Lotto Plus Raffle

On Saturday 19th August, a GUARANTEED €1 Million will be added to the Lotto Plus RAFFLE. This is the 3rd Lotto Plus €1 Million Raffle in 2023 and the 26th overall.

How do I play?

Buy a Lotto Ticket with Plus as normal, for each line on the ticket you get a non-unique raffle code between 0001 - 9999. Remember to check your raffle codes after every draw!

How do I win?

As per every Lotto Draw a lucky raffle code will be selected, any ticket with that code wins €500. On the 19th August all tickets with the winning raffle code will be placed in an additional raffle draw and one of these tickets will be drawn to win €1 million as well as their €500 prize.

Typically there are approximately 100 – 120 winners of the Lotto Plus Raffle every Saturday. This means that on Saturday 19th August one of the players with the winning raffle code on their ticket will win the usual €500 prize **plus €1 million!** The winning ticket will be placed on hold and when scanned the ticket owner will be advised to contact the National Lottery.



EuroMillions Super Minimum Jackpot €130m Guaranteed

This draw will take place community wide. The mechanic is the same as every other Jackpot draw but irrespective of the Jackpot size on Friday September 29th, the Jackpot will be a guaranteed €130 million. If the Jackpot is not won, the Jackpot in the following draw will continue in roll from the €130m base, to a predicted €145m and so on until it is won. This will be the second EuroMillions SMJG promotional event in 2023.

*If Jackpot is in roll above the €130m event maybe deferred.

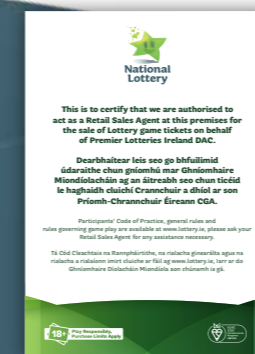
As you are aware the National Lottery is fully committed to promoting responsible play with the interests of our Players & Retailers central to everything we do.

The National Lottery operates a continuous Mystery Shopper campaign to test compliance.

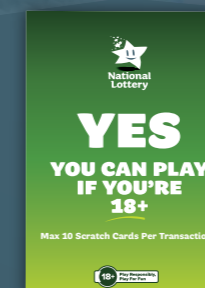
It is illegal to sell to anyone under the age of 18. **Remember when in doubt ask for ID.**

National Lottery Unveils 34 Outstanding Finalists for Prestigious Good Causes Awards 2023!

An orchestra that caters for the blind, a social enterprise that delivers large scale public artworks to transform neglected areas and a football team which helps people suffering from social exclusion to get back into the community are amongst thirty-four community groups, sports clubs and organisations from all over Ireland who were announced as National Finalists in this years' National Lottery Good Causes Awards.

Win number SIX for local newsagents in Kildare!

On the 12th of April, News4U in the Glenroyal Shopping Centre in Maynooth, Co. Kildare experienced its sixth big National Lottery win after they sold the winning ticket worth €500,000 in Wednesday's 9pm Daily Millions Plus draw. Patrick Cass, Owner of News4U, only took over the shop in February of this year and was shocked to get the call from the National Lottery about the win:

"I honestly can't believe it! I've just taken over the running of the shop about two months ago and already have a big National Lottery win under the belt! It's just fantastic. I had been hearing from people in the community that the shop had quite a few wins over the past number of years, so I wasn't really sure about it all until I got the call this morning!", he said.

The Maynooth newsagents sold its first big winning Lotto ticket worth €450,000 in August 2005 and a winning Lotto Plus 1 ticket worth €350,000 was purchased at the store seven years later in October 2012. Three EuroMillions Plus top prize wins worth €500,000 then followed in August of 2014, November 2016 and in August 2022. This latest Daily Million Plus win marks the sixth big Lotto win for the store since 2005.

Jackpot win in Westmeath!

On the 17th of June, TWO local stores in Westmeath and Donegal sold winning Lotto Jackpot tickets worth €6,373,878 each. One of those winning stores was Tuthills in the Golden Island Shopping Centre in Athlone. Joe Callinan, Manager of the store admitted that the news came as a huge surprise:

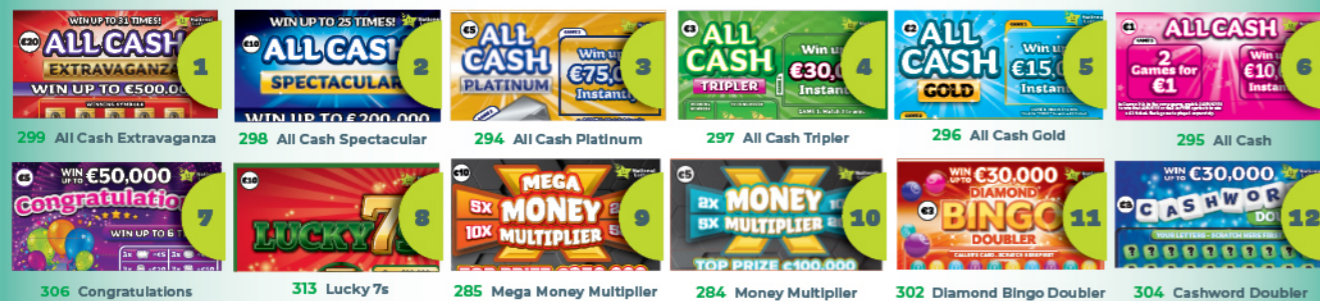
